Frequently Asked Questions
and Other Useful
Information

Q. How many can be in my group?

A. Minimum is 15, Maximum is 80.

Q. Can you bring boys and girls?

A. Yes, two sleeping quarters are on the ship. Both have air conditioning and heating.

Q. How old do you have to be to sleep onboard?

A. Minimum age is 6 y/o or be in First Grade

Q. What do I need to bring for sleeping?

A. A sleeping bag or blanket(s) and a pillow.

Q. Do you serve meals on the ship?

A. We do not serve an evening meal. Breakfast is catered and the choices are pancake/sausage on a stick, breakfast tacos or cereal. Milk, orange juice and coffee are provided as well.

Q. What should we wear?

A. Light shirt/shorts for summer. Shirt/sweater/coat/long pants for winter. Sneakers or hiking boots year around. If it looks like rain, bring a rain coat.

Q. Is there anything else we should bring?

A. Yes, drinks and snacks to eat during the movie. Also bring your organization's flag, bug spray, a flashlight.

Q. How much does it cost?

**A. The cost is:
\$42.00 per person (OCT – MAY)
\$32.00 per person (JUN – SEPT).
This includes the guided tour and breakfast.**

Q. What time does it start?

A. It's best to arrive at the ship around 5:30pm the day of your Overnight camping trip, the park closes at 6:00 PM. We will check you in, and make sure all the forms are filled out. You will be touring, and kept busy until after 10:00 PM. Taps signals bedtime, and Reveille will wake you in the morning. Breakfast, our flag raising, the morning tour, and our awards ceremony will last until 10:00 AM. When this is over you get . . . "Liberty". You are welcome to stay on board if you wish, and don't forget to visit our gift shop which opens at 10am.

Other Useful Information

- The Battleship TEXAS Overnight Education Program stresses military procedure, but in a fun manner.
- Boys/ girls will have separate sleeping quarters as well as separate bathroom facilities.

- Please try to arrive before the start of the program. The gate to the park closes at 6pm. If members of your group arrive after 6pm, they will have to be let in the gate by overnight staff. When arriving at a closed gate, have the late comers call a member of the group so that they can alert overnight staff.
- Please park in the parking lot closest to the channel.
- Please have all forms filled out prior to arrival. If possible, have all forms collected beforehand by the leader of the group. This speeds up the check-in process
- The Battleship TEXAS is a museum ship and a memorial. It is constantly going through renovations. Please be aware that certain areas of the ship might be closed due to renovations during your stay.
- Please keep all food and drinks besides water in the designated snack room areas.
- Don't forget your organization's flag. We will have a flag ceremony as part of the program.
- Please bring luggage/bags that you will be able to carry down to the second level of the ship.
